

Assistant Conductor, Centerville Community Band

Background

The Centerville Community Band (CCB) is a 70+ member group of amateur musicians from Centerville, Ohio and surrounding communities. The band is presently accepting letters of interest for an Assistant Conductor to begin in early 2014. The CCB rehearses on Tuesday evenings from 7-9 pm throughout the year at Centerville High School. The band typically has over 10 concerts a year and performs in parades on July 4 and Labor Day.

Position Description

The Assistant Conductor is responsible for assisting the Conductor with rehearsals and performances of the Band. At the discretion of the Conductor the Assistant Conductor will be responsible for conducting musical selections during rehearsals and performances and assisting with selecting musical literature. The Assistant Conductor must be a member of the band. If not currently a member, a successful applicant must join the band.

The position includes compensation for conducting rehearsals and performances.

Qualifications/Skills

- Prior conducting experience and knowledge of band literature.
- Demonstrate leadership qualities with conducting, teaching and communication skills.
- Has the ability to work with adult musicians of all skill and commitment levels.

Selection Process

Review of the letters of interest will begin **December 1, 2013**. Starting in January 2014, prospective conductors will be invited to attend and lead a rehearsal of the band.
