




City of Centerville Fall Internship – Civil Engineering Intern



The City of Centerville is accepting applications for a Civil Engineering Intern to assist the Public Works Engineering Department this Fall and provide a local student with hands-on engineering experience. The Civil Engineering Intern will become actively involved in construction management activities, traffic pattern/signal work, office administration, and other functions of the Centerville Public Works Engineering Division. Responsible students pursuing a Civil Engineering degree should apply as soon as possible for first consideration.

Civil Engineering Internship Position Responsibilities

The Civil Engineering Intern will assist the City's Engineering staff with the following: updating storm basin inventory database and corresponding field inspections; traffic sign and traffic signal inventory and database maintenance; miscellaneous traffic counts; inspection of street repair and resurfacing projects. The intern will work a flexible schedule (up to 40 hours/week) during the Fall months. Experience in AUTOCAD strongly desired, as duties include mapping updates and related assignments. Students working on a bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering or a closely related field are eligible to apply for consideration and should do so as soon as possible. The pay rate for this position is \$12.00 per hour.
