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CENTERVILLE STREET MAP RECEIVES **TOP HONORS**

The City of Centerville Street Map received top honors at the Ohio GIS (Geographic Information System) Conference recently held in Columbus. The Centerville City map won first place in the General Reference category and was recognized with the Best of Show award for all maps. Judging criteria included presentation of concept and purpose, technical merit and overall design. Sponsored by the County Engineer's Association of Ohio, Ohio Geographically Referenced Information Program and the Ohio Chapter of Urban and Regional Systems Association, more than 40 digital and paper maps were submitted for judging.

The recently redesigned map was created by Mark Yandrick, of the Centerville Planning Office, utilizing the latest in technology including ArcGIS and geodatabases to accentuate the buildings, parks, entities and other features in the City. This is the fourth time a City map and Yandrick have been recognized.
