



Cornerstone Connections is an email update from the City of Centerville on current and upcoming road/utility improvements near the Cornerstone of Centerville development at Wilmington Pike and Feedwire Road.

Update: October 22, 2015: Another project completed

[Wilmington Pike Improvements](#): Work is now complete on the ODOT widening project on Wilmington Pike that lengthened the left turn lanes to increase capacity for vehicles accessing I-675, both north and south. A southbound third lane was also added from the I-675 exit ramp south to Clio Road.

Phase II of the project will continue to widen Wilmington Pike from I-675 to Brown Road. Preliminary work is anticipated to start in the fall of 2015, with completion estimated in the fall of 2016.

Northbound Wilmington Pike near the Home Depot entrance and northward to Dille Drive was completed earlier this year. This is a multi-phase project.

Funding for these projects comes from a variety of sources including the City of Centerville, Ohio Public Works Commission, Greater Dayton RTA, the Federal Highway Administration and dollars provided via tax increment financing (TIF), generated by the new building values within the Cornerstone of Centerville.
