



An email update from the City of Centerville on current and upcoming road/utility improvements near the Cornerstone of Centerville development at Wilmington Pike and Feedwire Road.

[Wilmington Pike Improvements](#): Work is nearing completion on the turn lanes of Wilmington Pike under the I-675 overpass. TODAY, Thursday, Oct. 8, additional milling/paving is scheduled. Final pavement markings will follow, placing traffic into its final configuration. Work is anticipated to be completed--weather permitting--by Monday, Oct. 12. This will complete this phase of construction.

Phase I work is complete for northbound Wilmington Pike near the Home Depot entrance and northward to Dille Drive. This is a multi-phase project. Phase II of the project will continue to widen Wilmington Pike from I-675 to Brown Road. Preliminary work is anticipated to start in the fall of 2015, with completion estimated in the fall of 2016.

Funding for these projects comes from a variety of sources including the City of Centerville, Ohio Public Works Commission, Greater Dayton RTA, the Federal Highway Administration and dollars provided via tax increment financing (TIF), generated by the new building values within the Cornerstone of Centerville.
