



UPDATE: 8:30 p.m., July 6, 2015

[Wilmington Pike Improvements](#): Tomorrow morning, July 7, 2015, ODOT will start a widening project on Wilmington Pike that will include constructing outside lanes, curb, sidewalk and storm sewer under the I-675 overpass. Two lanes will be open during the peak drive time, 7-8:30 a.m. and 4:30 – 6:30 p.m. Otherwise, one lane in each direction will be open, in addition to the left turn lanes. This project provides additional capacity for vehicles accessing I-675, both north and south. Work will be completed by December 1, 2015.

Phase I work is now complete for northbound Wilmington Pike near the Home Depot entrance and northward to Dille Drive. This is a multi-phase project. Phase II of the project will continue to widen Wilmington Pike from I-675 to Brown Road. Preliminary work is anticipated to start in the fall of 2015, with completion estimated in the fall of 2016.
