## **CENTERVILLE COUNCIL TO HOST TAX LEVY INFORMATION MEETINGS**

Centerville City Council has scheduled three community meetings to answer questions and provide information regarding Issue 3, the proposed 0.5 percent income tax increase that will appear on the Nov. 8, 2016 ballot.

Citizens are invited to attend any of the meetings on the following: Monday, Oct. 24 in the Village Center of Bethany Lutheran Village, 6445 Far Hills Ave.; Wednesday, Oct. 26 in the Franciscan Center at St. Leonard, 8100 Clio Road; and Nov. 1 in the banquet room at The Golf Club at Yankee Trace. All meetings will be held at 6:30 p.m.

Issue 3 asks voters whether to approve a 0.5 percent income tax increase. With voter approval, it will increase the income tax from 1.75 percent to 2.25 percent to help maintain the quality of services the City of Centerville provides its citizens.
