### Vacation Credit

Four consecutive weeks or more of vacation qualify for a credit. Notify the Waste Billing office of vacation dates in advance: 937-428-4746.

## EXEMPTIONS

### Curbside/Houseline Exemptions

For households whose residents are infirmed or disabled and not able to put their containers to the curb, an application may be completed for an exemption. Upon approval by the City Manager, regular weekly trash will be picked up from the houseline.

### Hardship Exemptions

Residents who have a financial hardship inhibiting them from paying their waste bill may apply for an exemption from doing so with either a 100% or 50% reduction. Residents will be required to complete an application and provide current documentation of all income. Applications are subject to the City Manager's approval and annual eligibility is considered based on the current poverty levels set by the Federal government.

## SPECIAL SERVICES

### Special Pick Ups

Upon request, additional items that do not fit in the City container may be removed via a curbside pick up. Call 937-428-4782 to schedule.

#### Fee:

First 30 minutes

#### Guidelines:

- Carpet—4' long x 10" diameter rolls.
- Mattresses and boxsprings must be sealed in plastic (Bags available for purchase at Public Works).
- Brush piles—no piece longer than 8' and no wider than 10" in diameter.
- Not accepted: large amounts of building materials, wood with nails, automobile parts, tires, firewood, concrete, bricks, dirt or hazardous materials. *These items may be taken by the resident to appropriate hard fills—contact Public Works, 428-4782, for suggestions.*

### Operation Clean Sweep

A complimentary special pick up is scheduled for one week each year in the spring. Bulky items and yard waste will be removed for free on the collection day of each waste customer during that week. Refer to the Town Crier or [centervilleohio.gov](http://centervilleohio.gov) for specific dates and guidelines.

### Fall Leaf Pick Up

Leaves which have been piled at the curb will be picked up four times during the fall season. Refer to [centervilleohio.gov](http://centervilleohio.gov) or the Town Crier for the schedule for your neighborhood.

### Christmas Trees

During the first two weeks of January, undecorated trees which have been placed at the curb on your regular collection day will be picked up at no charge.

## WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES

Municipal Code - Chapter 1060 requires that all single-family residential units have waste collection service from the City of Centerville.

The City of Centerville Public Works Department provides once per week collection for waste and recyclables. Waste and recyclables must be placed at the curb (not in the street) by 7 a.m. on the designated pick up day.

**Waste** is placed in a City-provided container.

- Lid opening toward the street
- Minimum 3' clearance around container
- Maximum weight: 335 pounds

**Recyclables** are placed in either resident-provided or City-provided containers (*program will be phased in to provide all residents with a recycling container*).

- Resident-provided containers may not be larger than 32 gallons.
- Resident-provided containers must have City-provided "recyclables" label attached.
- See insert for current information on acceptable recyclable items.
- Large, flattened cardboard may be placed next to the container.

### Pick Up

For pick up, waste and recyclable containers should be placed on opposite sides of the driveway. Per City code, after collection, containers shall not be stored where they are visible from the street.

Refuse collection may be delayed one day for the following holidays: **New Year's Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day.** Refer to the *Town Crier*, [centervilleohio.gov](http://centervilleohio.gov) or your waste bill for current information regarding the upcoming holiday pick up schedule.

**Yard Waste** may be placed in the City-provided waste container or other options include:

- Mulching and composting are encouraged.
- Brush drop-off is available at Public Works Center, 7970 S. Suburban Rd. Proof of residency required. Tree and shrub trimmings only. Branches no longer than 8' and no wider than 10" in diameter.
  - Wednesdays 8 a.m.–4 p.m. and third Saturday of each month 9 a.m.–noon. This is a free service.

- Curbside pick up (see Special Pick Ups).
